# House Whites

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GLASS 175ML £5.75  
GLASS 250ML £7.75  
BOTTLE £22

- 1. Chardonnay, 16 Stops, Adelaide Hills, Australia - 12.5%**  
Bright and lifted with zesty citrus fruit and racy acidity.
- 2. Sauvignon Blanc, Villa Montes, Valle Central, Chile - 13%**  
Bright and lifted with a good balance of zesty citrus fruit with racy acidity.
- 3. Trebbiano/Garganega, Ponte Pietra, Veneto, Italy - 12.5%**  
Almond blossom and green apple aromas develop into a lively wine with subtle marzipan and honey.
- 4. 'P' Pinot Grigio, Alpha Zeta, Veneto, Italy - 13%**  
Hints of flint, ripe peach and pear. The wine is full-bodied and rich.
- 5. Piesporter Michelsberg, Karl Josef, Mosel, Germany - 8%**  
Notes of spice and zesty lemon with white peach and apricot flavours.
- 6. Organic Macabeo, Castaño, Murcia, Spain - 12%**  
A bright, fresh and fruity wine with notes of citrus and pear. On the palate it is soft with a lifted finish.

# House Reds

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- 7. Reserve Malbec, Kaiken, Mendoza, Argentina - 14%**  
Dried fruit aromas of strawberries and cherries complemented with spicy notes and menthol aromas.
- 8. Cabernet Sauvignon, Villa Montes, Valle Central, Chile - 14%**  
Aromas of blackberry and blackcurrant on the nose, with a medium-bodied palate and a long finish.
- 9. 'V' Valpolicella, Alpha Zeta, Veneto, Italy - 12.5%**  
Lively, cherry perfumes give way to a fresh, cherry pie. Soft, rounded and juicy with exuberant fruit.
- 10. Organic Monastrell, Familia Castaño, Yecla, Spain - 13.5%**  
A fresh red from Yecla full of blueberries and raspberries.
- 11. Colchagua Merlot, Montes Classic Series, Valle Central, Chile - 14%**  
Fresh raspberry, cherry and plum, with notes of vanilla, nutmeg, and caramel.
- 12. Shiraz, 16 Stops, McLaren Vale, Australia - 14%**  
Lovely dark fruit and spiced plum character. A ripe and silky wine.

# House Rosé

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- 13. Monastrell Rosado, Familia Castaño, Valencia, Spain - 13%**  
Fresh, red fruits aromas. Soft, fruity flavours with prominent cherry and strawberry and a long finish.
- 14. 'R' Rosato, Alpha Zeta, Veneto, Italy - 12.5%**  
A vibrant Rosato full of strawberries, sweet cherries and a subtle floral touch.

# White Wines

## SAUVIGNON & AROMATIC VARIETALS

15. **Viognier IGP Pays d'Oc, Baron de Badassière, Languedoc, France - 12.5%** £23  
A fresh, modern Viognier with almond and honey perfumes and flavours of guava and apricot.
16. **Sauvignon de Loire, 'Wally', Les Caves de la Loire, France - 11.5%** £23  
Zesty with lively acidity, hints of passion fruit and gooseberry with great balance and a clean finish.
17. **Albariño DO Rías Baixas, Martín Códax, Galicia, Spain - 12.5%** £26  
Fresh fruit flavours balance the creamy mouthfeel of this Albariño, with warm brioche flavours.
18. **Sauvignon Blanc, Tinpot Hut, Marlborough, New Zealand - 13.5%** £26  
A classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc with vibrant aromas of passionfruit, melon and blackcurrant. Finely balanced with a lingering finish.
19. **Sancerre, Domaine Sautereau, Loire, France - 12.5%** £30  
Floral aromas rounded off with a fresh grass scent. Flavours of green apple and white grapefruit with a mouthwatering finish.
20. **Sancerre (Half Bottle) - £16**

## SOMETHING SPECIAL

21. **Pouilly-Fumé, Domaine de Bel-Air, Loire, France - 13%** £38  
Fresh with lively citrus fruit, flint and pear flavours and a long crisp finish.
22. **Wild Sauvignon Blanc, Greywacke, Marlborough, New Zealand - 14%** £46  
Stone fruits, patisserie aromas and fresh herbs that mingle with vanilla and a hint of smoke.

## CHARDONNAY

23. **Chardonnay 'Les Ursulines', Jean-Claude Boisset, Burgundy, France - 12.5%** £29  
Notes of citrus, honeydew melon and white peach.
24. **Skye's English White, Hush Heath Estate, Kent, England - 11%** £29  
Citrus, thyme and pineapple aromas are balanced by rich, ripe grapefruit and apple flavours.
25. **Chablis, Laroche, Burgundy, France - 12.5%** £32  
Fresh with crisp, white fruit and classic Chablis minerality.
26. **Chablis (Half Bottle) - £17**
27. **Chardonnay, Trinity Hill, Hawkes Bay, New Zealand - 13.5%** £30  
Citrus, white flowers and stone fruit, with a creamy richness and notes of almond and hazelnut.

28. **Chablis 1<sup>er</sup> Cru 'Les Vaudevey', Domaine Laroche, Burgundy, France - 12.5%** £43  
White peach flavours. Racy and lively with a mineral finish.
29. **Meursault 'Sous La Velle', David Moret, Côte de Beaune, France - 13%** £60  
Powerful and round, with fabulous apple aromas.

### OTHER VARIETALS & BLENDS

30. **Pinot Grigio, Ponte del Diavolo, Friuli-Venezia-Giulia, Italy - 12.5%** £24  
Lively, freshly cut pear and baked bread character with a touch of sherbet and a nutty note.
31. **Pinot Gris, Tinpot Hut, Marlborough, New Zealand - 13%** £26  
Fragrant spice, pear and stone fruit mix with underlying notes of brioche and spring flowers.
32. **Soave Classico, Pieropan, Veneto, Italy - 12%** £27  
Fresh and expressive, with white flower, a touch of citrus and a hint of almond.

33. **Soave Classico (Half Bottle) - £14**

### SOMETHING SPECIAL

34. **'La Rocca' Soave Classico, Pieropan, Veneto, Italy - 13%** £38  
Almond and honey lead to elegant notes of vanilla, ripe apricots and exotic fruit.
35. **'Terre Alte', Livio Felluga, Friuli, Italy - 13%** £60  
Beautifully complex, with an array of vanilla, elderflower, stone fruits, soft fresh herbs and almonds.

# Rosé Wine

BOTTLE

36. **Pinot Grigio Rosato, Ponte Pietra, Veneto, Italy - 12%** £24  
A fresh, crisp Rosato full of strawberries and cherries.
37. **Rosé de la Chavelière, Mas la Chevalière, Béziers, France - 12.5%** £26  
A fruity yet delicate rosé with ripe redcurrant and strawberry perfumes.
38. **'Cuvée Alexandre' Rosé, Château Beaulieu, Provence, France - 13%** £28  
Abound with redcurrant and wild strawberry perfumes that develop into juicy white peach and pear notes. Refreshing, beautifully balanced and elegant.

# Red Wines

BOTTLE

## MERLOT, CABERNET & BORDEAUX BLENDS

39. **Malbec Clasico, Altos Las Hormigas, Mendoza, Argentina - 13%** £25  
Full of juicy, elegant red fruit, a touch of herbs and white pepper with silky tannins.
40. **Merlot, Fog Mountain, California, United States - 13.5%** £27  
Rich and structured, full of baked plums, cherries, violets and earthy notes.
41. **'Les Graves de Mahon-Laville' Graves, Bordeaux, France - 13.5%** £27  
Powerful but smooth, with hints of spiced plums.

### SOMETHING SPECIAL

42. **Château Larose-Perganson Haut-Médoc, Bordeaux, France - 14%** £36  
Black berries with spicy notes. Full with great structure and freshness, as well as elegant tannins.
43. **Château Capet-Guillier Saint-Émilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux, France - 13%** £46  
Deep in colour and full-bodied with dark berry fruits and spice.
44. **Château Dufort-Vivens 'Vivens' Margaux, Bordeaux, France - 13%** £50  
Intense aromas of cassis and blackberries with delicate layers of oak.

## SANGIOVESE

45. **Fantini Sangiovese IGT, Farnese, Abruzzo, Italy - 12%** £24  
Vibrant red fruit, cherries and herbal characters along with vanilla.
46. **Rosso di Montalcino, San Polo, Tuscany, Italy - 13%** £31  
Fresh berries and a trace of cherry with hints of blackberries, black cherries and vanilla.
47. **Chianti Classico, Fontodi, Tuscany, Italy - 14%** £33  
Deep juicy fruit flavours with notes of sour cherry, plums, leather and tobacco.

### SOMETHING SPECIAL

48. **Brunello di Montalcino, San Polo, Tuscany, Italy - 14%** £55  
Notes of violets, red berries and a touch of vanilla.
49. **Flaccianello, Fontodi, Tuscany, Italy - 14.5%** £76  
Aromas of ripe, dark cherries, violets and plums, complemented by a hint of spice.

# Red Wines

BOTTLE

## SYRAH/SHIRAZ & RHÔNE VARIETALS

50. **Shiraz/Viognier, Willunga 100, McLaren Vale, Australia - 14%** £26  
Rich and luscious wine with lifted aromatics, dark black berry fruit and supple tannins.
51. **Lirac, Moulin des Chenes, Southern Rhône, France - 14%** £27  
Strawberry and blackberry aromas and lovely freshness in the mouth.
52. **'Closierie de Vaudieu' Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Château de Vaudieu, Rhône, France - 14%** £33  
Berry, liquorice and black pepper on the nose, ripe tannins with cassis and herb characters.

### SOMETHING SPECIAL

53. **Gimblett Gravels Syrah, Trinity Hill, Hawkes Bay, New Zealand - 13.5%** £36  
Characters of wild raspberry and blackberry with spice undertones.
54. **Gigondas, Domaine des Bosquets, Southern Rhône, France - 15%** £39  
Blackberry, violet and liquorice aromas reflect the very black colour of this beautiful red.
55. **Nine Popes, Charles Melton, Barossa Valley, Australia - 14.5%** £60  
A soft blend with herbs on the nose and berry fruit flavours complemented by dried flower petals.

## PINOT NOIR & GAMAY

56. **Aconcagna Pinot Noir, Montes Alpha, Valle Central, Chile - 14%** £26  
Soft and silky with red plums, blackcurrant, white pepper and a touch of violets.
57. **Pinot Noir, Ribbonwood, Marlborough, New Zealand - 13.5%** £29  
This wine is lush and rounded on the palate, with raspberry, cherry and plum flavours, along with savoury, smoky bacon and dried herb notes
58. **Fleurie, Dominique Morel, Beaujolais, France - 12.5%** £29  
Violet, iris and red fruit aromas and a palate bursting with velvety tannins.
59. **Fleurie (Half Bottle) - £16**
60. **Savigny-Lès-Beaune, Jean-Claude Boisset, Burgundy, France - 12.5%** £39  
Bursting with red berries, ripe cherries and spice. Rich with velvety tannins, lingering finish.

### SOMETHING SPECIAL

61. **Pinot Noir, Burn Cottage, Central Otago, New Zealand - 13.5%** £51  
Red berry fruit flavours combine with wild thyme and rich savoury notes.
62. **Pinot Noir, Ata Rangī, Martinborough, New Zealand - 14%** £57  
Enticing floral aromas of star anise, crushed red rose that meld with savoury notes.
63. **Pommard 'Les Vaumuriens', Jean-Claude Boisset, Burgundy, France - 12.5%** £65  
Dried roses and spice with refined tannins and a long finish.



# Red Wines

BOTTLE

## TEMPRANILLO

64. **Tempranillo, Willunga 100, McLaren Vale, Australia - 14%** £25  
Fine, lifted intense aromatics and strong savoury tannins.

65. **Rioja Reserva, Izadi, Spain - 14%** £27  
Red fruit, liquorice, spices and hints of smoke. Full of floral and ripe fruit notes.

### SOMETHING SPECIAL

66. **Rioja Reserva, Orben, Spain - 14%** £38  
Wild fruit, balsamic aromas, toasty oak and toffee aromatics that continue through the finish.

67. **Rioja A Mano Edicion Limitada, Bodegas LAN, Rioja, Spain - 13.5%** £55  
Aromas of ripe plums, blackberry and redcurrant with hints of clove and cinnamon.

## OTHER REDS

68. **Primitivo, A Mano, Puglia, Italy - 14%** £25  
A smoky wine with ripe, red fruit, especially raspberries and a spicy edge.

69. **Valpolicella, Allegrini, Veneto, Italy - 13.5%** £27  
Brilliant cherry perfumes, fresh black pepper and aromatic herbs.

70. **Valpolicella (Half Bottle) - £15**

71. **'Lo Mainatge' La Croix de St Jean, Minervois, France - 14.5%** £30  
Fresh and sweet fruit on the juicy palate with a subtle spice.

### SOMETHING SPECIAL

72. **'A' Amarone, Alpha Zeta, Veneto, Italy - 15%** £38  
Deep and intense with cherries, blueberries, spiced autumn fruit compote and cherry characters.

73. **Massolino, Barolo, Piemonte, Italy - 14%** £55  
Dark, dried plum and autumn compote fruit with perfumes of roses and violets on the finish.

# Champagne & Sparkling Wine

BOTTLE

74. **Devaux Grande Réserve, Champagne, France - 12%** £40  
Lovely Pinot Noir richness with aromas of baked apples and vanilla and a full, rounded finish.
75. **Prosecco Superiore, Ca' Morlin, Veneto, Italy - 11%** £27  
Soft, scented with grape aromas with delicious lightness and a long lasting 'mousse'.
76. **Devaux Cuvée Rosé, Champagne, France - 12%** £49  
Complex, with very fine bubbles, a creamy mouth-feel, flavours of raspberry, strawberries, some hazelnut notes and a long finish.
77. **Charles Heidsieck Brut Réserve, Champagne, France - 12%** £55  
Complex pastry aromas, with a combination of ripe apricot, mango, dried fruits, pistachio and almond. The palate develops into ripe fleshy apricot, melon and enticing plum pastry notes and delicate spice.
78. **2005 Charles Heidsieck Brut Millésimé, Champagne, France - 12%** £85  
Autumnal aromas and warm with notes of praline and lightly toasted hazelnuts. The palate is rich with intense notes of dried apricots, dates and figs.

# Dessert Wine

79. **Barossa Valley Botrytis Semillon, Peter Lehmann Masters, South Australia - 11%** £5 £20  
A deliciously luscious dessert wine full of honey and lime marmalade characters.
80. **Château Laville Sauternes, Bordeaux, France - 13%** £5 £24  
Intense aromas of candied fruits, honey and spice. A lively citrus twist to round it off.
81. **'Cordon Cut' Riesling, Mount Horrocks, Clare Valley, Australia - 12%** £6 £26  
Intense floral, spice and lemon aromas. A juicy zest with lively pear and citrus fruit flavours tingle the palate.
