01 Muscadet Sèvre-et-Maine Sur Lie, Domaine de la Chauvinière, France 12% ABV	£24
Full of ripe fruit on the nose and palate, pears and citrus abound.	
02 Picpoul de Pinet, Emma M Louise, France 13% ABV	£25
Elegant, attractive floral fruit with good crispness and citrus notes.	
03 Sancerre, André Dezat et Fils, France 13% ABV	£30
Fine Sancerre, bone dry with a great depth of mineral and herbaceous fruit.	
04 Mâcon-Vergisson, Les Rochers, Domaine Guerrin & Fils, France 13.5% ABV	£27
From one parcel of vines on top of the spectacular Vergisson escarpment comes this delightfully mineral, 'bready', Chablis-style Mâcon. It's a great fish or shellfish wine.	
05 Preciso Pinot Grigio, Terre Siciliane, Italy 12.5% ABV	£22
Fresh and easy with juicy fruit, lemony hints and an attractive style.	
06 Bernon Albariño, Rias Baixas, Bodegas Aquitania, Spain 13% ABV	£26
Creamy fruit with plenty of flavour and appealing underlying minerality.

	A fresh and aromatic white with juicy fruit, suitable for all occasions.	
	<b>11 Vouvray, Clos le Vigneau, Château Gaudrelle, France</b> <i>13% ABV</i>	<b>£30</b>
	Only just sweet with lovely acidity, so that at no time is it cloying. Delicately delicious.	
	<b>12 Henri Ehrhart Riesling, grand cru Kaefferkopf, Alsace, France</b> <i>12.5% ABV</i>	<b>£29</b>
	The Kaefferkopf vineyard at Ammerschwir is renowned for its elegant, mineral Rieslings and was upgraded to a well merited grand cru status in 2007. Fragrant and powerful with intense, juicy lime fruit and fine minerality.	
	<b>13 Piesporter Michelsberg, Moselland, Germany</b> <i>8.5% ABV</i>	<b>£22</b>
	Typically light on its feet, with a fresh grapey character.	
	<b>14 Fernanda Cappello Friulano, Friuli Grave, Italy</b> <i>12.5% ABV</i>	<b>£25</b>
	Floral notes on the nose with melon and fresh mown grass; soft, round palate with apple and spices.	
	<b>15 Perfect Cut Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand</b> <i>12.5% ABV</i>	<b>£25</b>
	Tropical fruit, grassy herbaceous character and ripe citrussy freshness.	
	<b>16 Kumeu Village Hand Harvested Pinot Gris, Auckland, New Zealand</b> <i>13.5% ABV</i>	<b>£26</b>
	Rich and complex, this has a lovely floral quality and a luscious weight on the dry finish.

	Pleasing intensity of fruit aromas with floral notes such as jasmine and white roses. On the palate it is light, with vibrant acidity, and a perfect balance.

	Wonderfully inviting with white orchard and yellow plums and floral notes.	
	<b>20 Greco di Tufo, Loggia della Serra, Terredora Di Paolo, Italy</b> <i>13.5% ABV</i>	<b>£31</b>
	Almond and smoky aromas then succulent, sweet grapefruit palate.	
	<b>21 Capellania, Rioja Blanco, Marqués de Murrieta, Spain</b> <i>12.5% ABV</i>	<b>£40</b>
	Full and oaky style, not quite as full on as in days gone by, this has a some good citric freshness to balance the vanilla and waxy style. Grown at altitude from fifty year old vines in the Capellania at the Ygay estate.	
	<b>22 Freedom Cross Chardonnay, Western Cape, Franschhoek Cellar, South Africa</b> <i>13.5% ABV</i>	<b>£22</b>
	Lightly oaked with flavours of lychee and melon and hints of butterscotch.	
	<b>23 La Petite Ferme Viognier, Franschhoek, South Africa</b> <i>13.5% ABV</i>	<b>£25</b>
	Peach, frangipan and hints of spice characterise this complex white.	
	<b>24 Churchill's Estates Branco, Douro, Portugal</b> <i>12.5% ABV</i>	<b>£28</b>
	Grapes grown at high altitude make this wine as fresh as fresh can be. Biscuity and flavoursome, with a twist of lime. An outstanding example of Portuguese wine.






	Full of juicy, raspberry fruit flavours and fine acidity this is a light and refreshing red.	
	<b>28 Fleurie, Domaine des Communaux, Jacques Charlet, France</b> <i>13.5% ABV</i>	<b>£30</b>
	Attractive, wild strawberry fruit is abundant in this wine making it a particularly juicy and good value example. Fleurie is the most famous of the ten superior, 'cru' villages of Beaujolais.	
	<b>29 Bardolino Classico, Zeni, Italy</b> <i>12.5% ABV</i>	<b>£24</b>
	Pale appearance, juicy fruit and soft tannin, very easy drinking.	
	<b>30 Roero, Tibaldi, Italy</b> <i>14.5% ABV</i>	<b>£38</b>
	Plenty of bright fruit on the palate, cherries and red fruits, well balanced tannins and a crisp, positive finish. Roero lies to the north of Alba, along the Tanaro River.	
	<b>31 Kate Radburnd 'Vine Velvet' Pinot Noir, Wairarapa, New Zealand</b> <i>13.5% ABV</i>	<b>£28</b>
	Succulent red and black fruit flavours. Good body and well balanced.
